



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Group Size

TransAndalusia trips are organized for groups of 7 - 10 pilots.

Meet and Pick-up of the Group

The group should land at Malaga airport arriving on the same flight or in the case of different flights, the wait between flights should not exceed 60 minutes. The trip begins on Sunday from midday and ends the following Sunday at noon. Air travel to and from Malaga airport is at the expense of the group.

Bookings

All persons wishing to participate in a TransAndalusia holiday must send the completed registration form a minimum of 45 days before the start date along with a deposit of 25% of the full price. The remaining 75% is payable on arrival in Andalusia.

Cancellation

In the case of cancellation by the organisation due to insufficient numbers, the participants will be made aware 30 days before the start date and all deposits will be refunded in full.

In the case of cancellation by the participant, the organization will refund the deposit paid according to the following: cancellation 30 days before the start date, 100% of the deposit paid, cancellation 20 days before the start date, 50% and cancellation 15 days before the start date, 10% of the deposit paid.

In the case of cancellation during the stay for medical or personal reasons, or for days not flyable due to weather conditions, the participants are not entitled to any refund or compensation.

Essential Documentation

The minimum level of paragliding experience required is that of a fully licensed club pilot, (front take-off, landing, ground handling control in 15/20 km/h winds). Pilots must hold a current license and **RCA** + repatriation insurance (please attach photocopies) and understand that they are flying at their own risk at all times during their stay.

(For those who do not hold a European paragliding license, remember to request coverage for Spain from your federation). Each participant must be in possession of a current and valid Identity card or passport and a credit card in their name.

Essential Equipment

Paraglider, harness, reserve parachute, helmet, radio, gloves, shoes with good ankle protection and a mobile phone. (Do not forget phone chargers, radios chargers, etc.)

Recommended equipment and accessories

Variometer, sunglasses, sunscreen, lip protector and water bottle.

(Remember to be careful of excess weight in the aircraft).

During the stay

We aim to fly at the different sites in Andalusia, the choice based on the weather and the level of experience within the group. Although each flight is exclusively the responsibility of the pilot,

for us safety is paramount on each trip. Due to this, we may forbid take-off if we feel that the safety of the pilot may be at risk. The choice of destination for the next day's flying will be made every evening depending on the weather forecast for the following day. In the middle of the stay, we all will take a night off to spend as we choose (guides included).
